Getting there

To travel from Helsinki to Kuopio (about 400 km), you can choose either plane (https://finnair.com), train (https://vr.fi), or bus.

Note: Exceptionally extensive renovation will take place at Kuopio Airport in the summer of 2024. Due to the renovation work, flights to and from Kuopio will be suspended from June 24 to August 6, 2024.

From August 7, there are several flights daily between Kuopio and Helsinki again.

Directly from the Helsinki Airport, there are train connections to Kuopio. Buses to Kuopio leave from Helsinki central bus station (Kamppi).
